At the Court of Oxford County Commissioners begun and held at Paris, Maine within and for the County of Oxford at 5:55 PM on July 5, 2012 being a special session, there were present:

Annalee Rosenblatt, labor consultant, and Dana Dillingham, corrections officers' union shop steward, were also present at this session.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The agenda was then adopted unanimously.

The Chairman asked for public comment. In response, Dana Dillingham thanked the Commissioners for their willingness to convene a meeting on short notice.

5:57 Executive Session – NCEU

The Commissioners unanimously voted to enter executive session to discuss labor negotiations with corrections employees represented by the National Corrections Employees Union. The county's labor consultant and Administrator entered this session as well.

The commissioners came out of executive session at 7:05 PM, and took the actions described below.

Mr. Dillingham re-entered the meeting room.

Ratification of Agreements

Commissioner Duguay motioned with second by Chairman Merrill, that the Administrator be authorized, on behalf of the Oxford County Commissioners to execute an agreement between Oxford County and the National Correctional Employees Union, for the period July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.

The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Duguay then motioned with second by Chairman Merrill, that the Administrator be authorized, on behalf of the Oxford County Commissioners to execute an agreement between Oxford County and the National Correctional Employees Union, for the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2014.

The motion was also unanimously approved.

Following the votes, Chairman Merrill remarked that he was also in favor of the county's effort to eliminate so-called "insta-pay," in reference to a longstanding practice of paying county employees, hired prior to 2005, for the anticipated total hours to be worked in a given pay cycle prior to the end of that pay cycle.

7:08 Executive Session – OCDA

The Commissioners unanimously voted to enter executive session to discuss labor negotiations with patrol deputies represented by the Oxford County Deputies Association. The county's labor consultant and Administrator entered this session as well.

The Commissioners came out of executive session at 7:30 PM, and took no action.


7:32 Review of Letter

No other bills or accounts were given consideration on the 5th day of July, 2012. The Commissioners adjourned at 7:35 PM.




